*Morning coffee taken into the studio 5 days a week and then it begins. //re changed during _ I've had many different studios from Vancouver to Montreal, Paris, Helsinki, Sofia etc to my current one on the Sunshine Coast. Some solo, some shared, each one had a different flavour, but the beginning is always the same – a blank canvas and the first brushstroke.

What sorts of things inspire you?

*Everything—There is a kind of call and response between the world and myself & then a call and response between the painting & me.
